

DOs and DONTs in comment writing

😊 Please DO...	Example	😞 Please DON'T...	Example
...describe how the target deviates from source (rather than the other way around)	😊 "wild" added to "horse" "horse" translated as "wild horse" 😞 ENG source only reads "horse", not "wild horse"	...describe what it reads in the source but rather how the target deviates from source	😞 In ENG source it reads "book" 😞 Not "booklet" 😊 "book" translated as "booklet"
...make sure that the location of your intervention is clear	😊 "True" and "False" left in English in the first sentence	...describe the issue through the action performed by you	😞 Ver changed "house" to "building" 😊 "building" translated as "house"
...use back-translations whenever useful, and ALWAYS in the case of mistranslation	😊 "donkey" translated as "monkey"	...write comments that are not understandable to reviewers that do not understand the target language	😞 "քըցխ" changed to "հընշլիսլզզ" (Which term is the comment referring to? Who made the change? Why?) 😊 "building" translated as "house"
...advise, if your comment is FYI only	😊 FYI: in Zedish "with backbone" and "vertebrate" have the same root word, which makes the correct answer obvious. Unchanged by Ver	...refer to other studies	😞 Ver prefers the answering categories as used in TIMSS 😊 Ver suggests categories "ZZ", "YY", "WW" for better equivalency to source
... ALWAYS advise whether or not you made an intervention	😊 OK now / Unchanged by Ver 😊 Text not fully visible. Ver was <i>unable to change</i> 😞 Text caption not fully visible	...use sarcasm, criticism, exclamation marks, offensive language.	😞 As usual, the Zedish team has <i>AGAIN</i> used as many as four different synonyms for "car"!!! while source uses same word throughout the unit 😊 Four different synonyms used for "building". <i>Harmonized</i> by Ver 😞 Translation clumsy 😊 Translation not natural, better wording suggested by Ver
...use impersonal and neutral approach	😊 Verifier feels... <i>Changed by Ver(ifier)</i> 😞 I think... <i>I changed</i>	...describe grammar issues in great detail	😞 Possessive suffix 'si' missing. The suffix is always required if the main word is preceded by a possessive pronoun. Sometimes it can be dropped, if the 'owner' of the object is clear from context, but in this case this is not possible. 😊 Possessive suffix 'si' missing.
